Bio questionnaires will then be sent to each accepting candidate, which will be printed in the bulletin for 2 weekends, Sept 28th-29th and Oct. 5th-6th. Elections will be held at the Masses on Oct. 12th and 13th (men's CRHP will have ballots available to them at their Retreat.) Installation Mass for newly elected members will Oct. 27th. All current and outgoing members will also be asked to attend.

Stewardship Plans: Bev will meet with Finance Committee to obtain information on the financial needs of the parish to sustain our current ministries and to implement new ones.

Virtus Training: The training is required of all volunteers spending at least 1 hour with children a year. The training addresses the issue of safety for the children in the present time and guard against false accusations of the adult volunteers in the future. The program is beneficial to anyone spending time with children whether a volunteer or not, i.e. parent grandparent, and is hoped to be utilized by everyone. There is a June 1st deadline to have completed the Virtus training and be re-fingerprinted for all those who have previously been trained in other programs and fingerprinted.
